MILITARY SPECIFICATION

HARNESS, DOG LEADING (LEATHER)

This amendment forms a part of Military Specification MIL-H-43210A, dated 30 December 1968, and is approved for use by all Departments and Agencies of the Department of Defense.

PAGE 1

2.1, under listing of Federal Specifications.- Delete "PPP-F-320" in its entirety. Add in the proper sequence, "FF-R-556 - Rivet, Solid, Small; Rivet, Split, Small; Rivet, Tubular, Small; Burr; and Cap, Rivet; General Purpose."

Under listing of Military Specifications.- Delete "MIL-R-2583" in its entirety.

PAGE 2

2.1, under listing of Standards.- Add:

"FEDERAL

FED-STD-311 - Leather; Methods of Sampling and Testing."

Under listing of Military Standards.- Delete "MIL-STD-147" in its entirety.

Add the following new paragraph in proper sequence:

"2.2 Other publications.- The following documents form a part of this specification to the extent specified herein. Unless a specific issue is identified, the issue in effect on date of invitation for bids or request for proposal shall apply.

3.1 Delete in its entirety and substitute:

"3.1 First article.-- When specified, the supplier shall furnish a sample for first article inspection and approval (see 4.2, 6.2, and 6.4)."

3.2, after "Materials".-- Add "and components."

3.2.1, line 1.-- Delete "type I or II" and substitute "any type".

Line 2, after "shall be".-- Add, "designated as 8 to 10 or 12 to 14 ounce".

PAGE 3

3.2.2 Delete in its entirety and substitute:

"3.2.2 Buckle.-- The center bar buckle shall conform to type I, class 2, size 1 inch of MIL-B-2505 and shall be cadmium plated in accordance with class 1, type I of QQ-P-416."

3.2.3, title and first sentence.-- Delete in their entirety and substitute: "Rivet and burr. The belt rivets shall conform to type I, class 2, grade A, size 9 with corresponding copper burrs of FF-R-556."

3.2.4 Delete in its entirety and substitute:

"3.2.4 Ring, dee.-- The dee ring shall conform to configuration E, class 2 of MIL-R-3390, and shall be cadmium plated in accordance with class 1, type I of QQ-P-416."

4.2, at the end of the paragraph.-- Add "The presence of any visual defect or any dimension not within the specified requirements shall be cause for rejection of the first article."

PAGE 5

4.3.2.2, line 2, after "table II".- Insert "Leather thickness shall be determined in accordance with the procedure specified for fabricated leather articles in method 1011 of FED-STD-311."

PAGES 6 & 7

4.3.4 and Table IV.- Delete in their entirety.

PAGE 8

5.2.2.1, line 2.- Delete "V3c or V3s" and substitute "V3c, V3s, or V4s".

Last sentence.- Delete in its entirety.

5.2.3, second sentence.- Delete in its entirety and substitute, "Containers shall be in accordance with Uniform Freight Classification Rules or National Motor Freight Classification Rules, as applicable."

5.3 Delete in its entirety.

5.4 Delete in its entirety and substitute:

"5.4 Marking.- In addition to any special marking required by the contract or order, each harness, intermediate box, and shipping container shall be marked in accordance with MIL-STD-129."

PAGE 9

6.2, subparagraph (b).- Delete in its entirety and substitute:

"(b) When a first article is required (see 3.1)."

Subparagraph (f) - Delete in its entirety.

Add the following new paragraph in proper sequence:

"6.4 First article.- When a first article is required, it shall be inspected and approved under the appropriate provisions of ASPR 7-104.55. The first article should be a preproduction sample, initial production item, or other specific item described under the definition of a First Article in the ASPR. The contracting officer should specify the appropriate type of first article and the number of units to be furnished. The contracting officer should include specific instructions on all procurement instruments regarding arrangements for inspection and approval of the first article."
